Joint Controllers

Eurocare is organising the webinar with the YHO (International Youth Health Organization) and Romtens Foundation, who are the Joint Controllers of processing of personal data, as specified by Art. 26 of the GDPR. Why and how do we process your personal data?

We organize the FYFA webinar on 28 May 2020 and we collect and use your personal information to facilitate your registration and participation to the webinar. Your data will be collected by means of an online registration form, webinar recording and evaluation form.

Publication and sharing of your data

Speakers' presentations and the webinar will be recorded using Zoom tool. The recording of the FYFA webinar and presentations will be published at www.fyfaproject.eu website, through FYFA project communication channels (Twitter, Facebook, newsletter, YouTube) and in FYFA project materials. It will be used for reporting purposes to the Consumers, Health, Agriculture and Food Executive Agency (CHAFEA) under the grant agreement provisions.

Legal ground(s)do we process your personal data

We will use personal data only for the purpose for which the permission is given. We will not sell, rent, loan, trade or lease any personal information collected online or offline. All information shall be kept confidential unless given consent to by the user. We will not share personal information with others, apart from CHAFEA, which is managing the grant agreement and might request access for the purposes of the project verification and audit.

Which personal data do we collect and process further?

In order to carry out this processing operation the joint controllers collect the following categories of personal data:

- Name
- Surname
- Name of organization
- Position in the organization
- Type of the organization represented
- Country
- E-mail addresses
- Age
- Gender

How long do we keep your personal data?

All personal data related to the organisation and management of the webinar (this includes the information given during the registration, before, during or after the event) will be deleted seven years after the conference.

How do we protect and safeguard your personal data?

We use secure data networks that are protected by password protection systems. Our security and privacy policies are periodically reviewed and enhanced as necessary. Only authorized individuals have access to the information provided by our contacts. Our databases are located in Belgium, Norway, Slovenia, Romania. Zoom and Google Forms are GDPR complaint tools.

What are your rights?

Everyone can ask for a copy of the personal information we have about you. Everyone has the right to request access, modification, correction and removal of personal data collected in our database.
